This policy defines the Corps of Cadets residential requirements for academic year 2017 - 2018. It will be posted online via the Policies and Procedures section of my.norwich.edu.

The Corps of Cadets is a four-year, in-residence, progressive leadership and character development program. All cadets residing on campus will abide by the full provisions of the NUSRR governing membership in the Corps of Cadets. Any cadet who has completed eight semesters in residence in the Corps of Cadets shall be considered to have completed the Corps residency requirement. All fifth and subsequent year cadets are required to live off campus, except for fifth and sixth year architects. All cadets residing off campus will abide by the provisions of the NUSRR for fifth year cadets.

All returning members of the Corps of Cadets who have not fulfilled their residency requirements must:

- Complete and submit their housing form by April 1, 2017
- Pay their advanced deposit of \$250 by April 1, 2017.
- Register for classes by April 17, 2017.
- Not be on financial hold.
- Not be on a disciplinary hold.

Failure to complete one or more of the required actions by the due dates specified above may result in the student being removed from the Corps of Cadets and placed in residential civilian housing. In this situation, the student's financial aid package is subject to review. Housing assignments will be made on a space available basis.
